Community Rowing, Inc. is located at the 20 Nonantum Road in Brighton.

By Car from Boston:

Take Storrow Dr. West towards Newton.

Storrow Dr. turns into Soldiers Field Rd. at the BU Bridge.

Continue on Soldiers Field Rd. towards Newton.

The Charles River will be on your right, while the road will curve to the left.

After passing the IHOP restaurant (at N. Beacon St. intersection), Soldiers Field Rd. turns into Nonantum Rd.

Pass straight through one stoplight.

Look for the Harry Parker Boathouse on your right just after the light, before the baseball field.

By Bus:

Bus # 64 (which can be accessed by the Central Square T Stop):

Get off bus at Brooks Street near Nonantum Road.

Walk down Brooks, north towards the Charles River.

Turn left on Nonantum Road at the lights.

Walk down Nonantum with the river on your right and the boathouse will be on your right before the baseball field.

Walking time is approximately 5 minutes.

Buses #501, 57, or 64:

Take Bus to Oak Square

Walk east down Faneuil Street

Take a left down Brooks Street and walk to Charles River

Take a left on Nonantum Road at the lights after the bridge, putting the river on your right.

The MDC Skating Rink will be on your right after the baseball field.

By T:

Take the Green B Line to the Washington Street Station

Take Bus #65 to Brighton Center to connect with Bus #501 or 57 and follow directions above.
